Apricot Kernel Oil	Apricot Kernel Oil an expeller pressed oil that is a light weight oil that is high in Vitamin A Rich, Oleic Acid and Linoleic Acid. It has an excellent texture that is great for all skin types. It exhibits skin softening and moisturizing properties and is therefore recommended for skin that has is dry, irritated or has prematurely aged. It can be used in soap, lotion and cosmetic formulations.

Emu Oil	Emu Oil is an incredible lipid replenishing ingredient. It's unique penetrating properties make it an excellent carrier vehicle for other ingredients. Emu Oil makes bar soaps less drying and has been used in Australia for thousands of years as a natural remedy for the treatment of skin disorders such as eczema, psoriasis, burns, sunburns, abrasions and dry skin. It is believed to have natural anti-inflammatory properties. This oil will appear creamy below 65° F.
Evening Primrose Oil	Our Evening Primrose Oil is extracted (without the use of solvents) from the Evening Primrose Plant. It offers an unusually concentrated source of gamma-linolenic acid (GLA), with 7% to 10% of its fatty acids available in the form of GLA. Highly recommended for dry skin.

Hemp Seed Oil	Hemp Seed Oil has been used for centuries in skin care due to its excellent moisturizing properties. It is one of the "driest" natural oils available, penetrating quickly! It has a high content of Essential Fatty Acids. Hemp seed oil may be used in body care, bar soaps, facial creams, lotions and sunscreens to impart moisturization, particularly for dry, damaged skin (i.e. eczema, psoriasis and mastalgia.) It provides high fluidity and excellent lubricity without being greasy. Unrefined Hemp Seed Oil will have a much darker color and slight odor. Jobba Oil	Jobba Oil is cold pressed from the seeds of the desert shrub <i>Simmondsia Chinensis</i> , found growing wild in the southwest USA. It is actually not oil, but an array of wax esters. Jojoba oil acts as a moisturizer & emollient agent to improve skin elasticity and suppleness. It contains natural Vitamin E to minimize oxidation.
Olive Oil	Olive Oil production begins by transforming the olive fruit into olive paste. Olive Oil droplets are then produced from this paste. Olive Oil a cold pressed oil that is high in oleic acid, good for skin cell regeneration. Extra Virgin Olive Oil is the first pressing of the olives without use of chemical treatments. Considered the most natural of all Olive Oils. Traditionally, the only vegetable oil used to produce castile soap is olive oil.
Olive Squalane	This clear fluid oil has a natural affinity to the skin since it is one of the main components of human sebum. It has excellent spread ability and skin absorption. It prevents moisture loss and restores the skin suppleness and flexibility. Olive Squalane is soft, silky, and not greasy to touch. Due to its high content of unsaponifiables, it protects the skin against weather, sun and aging. Shea is well known to assist cutaneous dryness, dermatitis and dermatoses, eczema, solar erythema and burns.
Soybean Oil	Soybean Oil is ideal as a massage oil or carrier for treatment products. It allows for the infusion of lipids (oil like substances) to hydrate and protects skin cells. Soybean Oil replenishes the lipid barrier to help hold in the skins intrinsic moisture while softening dry, chaffed and damaged skin.

Shea Butter	Shea Butter is obtained from the seed of the Karite Tree (<i>Butyrospermum Parkii</i>) common to West Africa. From these seeds a soft, pliant "butter" is expeller pressed without the use of solvents, making it suitable for use in soaps, cosmetics, and toiletries. Ultra Refined Shea Butter is deodorized and filtered using natural clays to render a "butter" which is nearly white and odorless. Shea Butter is known to benefit dry skin. Melts at skin temperature.
